As the Final of the UEFA Women's EURO 2022 rolls into London, Green Street, with its vibrant culture and rich footballing heritage, is the inspiration for a series of activities and events celebrating women, football and culture.



# How to get here

# Foot/bike

With traffic-free dockside walking and cycling routes all across the Royal Docks, why not stroll or cycle to see us?

# River

Catch the Thames Clipper, which departs every 20 minutes, from the London Eye to the O2, then take a fiveminute walk to the Emirates Air Line.

# DLR

With 11 DLR stops on the north and south sides across the Royal Docks, you're never far from a station.

## Crossrail

Take the Elizabeth Line to Custom House (a 10-minute journey from Liverpool Street).

## Car

The Royal Docks are easily accessible from the M25, M11, A406 and A13.

# Cable car

Take London's only cable car, the Emirates Air Line, from Greenwich Peninsula to Royal Victoria and arrive from the air.
